The Client

The SCTS is the representative body for cardiothoracic surgery in Great Britain & Ireland; an independent self-funded organization, responsible only to its members.

The Mission

To provide a seamless solution to manage all aspects of the SCTS Annual General meeting from abstract submission and review, registration and ticketing through to schedule creation and on-demand conference badge printing.

Additionally, the solution would automatically feed all conference schedule content through to a bespoke native mobile app, event website and print-ready authors guide. Complete analytics data would be maintained to collate data generated from in app polling, rating of presentations and badge scanning activity, through the in-app lead tracking utility.

The Solution

The 'Eventflo-Custom' platform provided a unique solution incorporating all the functionality required including capabilities to manage details such as invited guest speakers, abstract scoring, automated emailing of abstract applicant's acceptance status, Add-On booking for dinners and full financial reporting.

Costs & Timescales

Total implementation of the Eventflo solution took only 4 weeks including launch of the Eventflo iOS/Android Apps and Event Microsite. The conference management team were up and running following only 3hrs training. Total costs were maintained below £10k including supply of Eventflo staff to manage the Eventflo supplied gate entry equipment, on-demand badge printing and walk-in registration work stations.
